

UCS Vaccination Exemption Review Committee:

- The UCS Vaccination Exemption Review Committee (Committee) will initially meet as a full group. As necessary, the Committee may be divided into two working groups, as indicated below, i.e., A and B Groups, to handle the expected volume of exemption requests.
 - **Note:** as of this morning, we have received 1,131 requests for exemptions from nonjudicial employees statewide [605 NYC, 526 ONYC] - I do not have a breakdown of how many are religious v. medical.
- The Committee consists of professionals from diverse background and areas of expertise which include executive, human resources, legal, Americans with Disabilities (ADA) and/or management experience [or some combination thereof].
- In the event of a full Committee meeting, quorum will be five voting members.
- Working groups will consist of five or six voting members. A minimum of three voting members are required for a working group to make a determination upon any exemption request.
- Meetings will be conducted by videoconference unless otherwise indicated by the chair.
- All materials submitted by requestors, Committee discussions and Committee communications are confidential. Materials will not be disseminated, nor their contents disclosed, outside of the Committee.
- Each exemption request will be anonymized by Counsel to the Committee or the Committee Administrator before presentation/review by the Committee through assignment of a unique, non-identifying control number and redaction of any identifying information such as name, title and address, or other information as necessary that could be identifying.
- All requestors will receive written notification of determination from the Committee's Administrator or Counsel and/or where applicable, notification that additional information is needed to consider their request/render a determination.
- The determination of the Committee is final, i.e., there is no administrative/internal mechanism for appealing the determination of the Committee.
